Overview Of Our Training Program:

A twenty hour training program must be attended by all volunteers. During the training, our Volunteers will receive information about all aspects of Hospice Care.

Topics include but are not limited to:

- Overview of hospice philosophy and eligibility
- Concept of death, dying and grief
- Confidentiality and HIPAA
- Safety and Infection Control
- The Hospice family including care, comfort measures and pain control
- Psychosocial and spiritual aspects of death and dying
- Managing stress for the Volunteer
- Patient and family rights
- A shadow visit with Volunteer Coordinator
- Upon completion of training you will receive:

"Certificate of Completion"



Volunteer Responsibilities:

Direct Patient Care:

Visiting patients in their home environment giving respite care to caregivers, running errands, just sitting with the patient for companionship; watching T.V., reading or reviewing their life stories as they share with the Volunteer.

Indirect Patient Care:

Filing patient files, data entry and phone calls.
